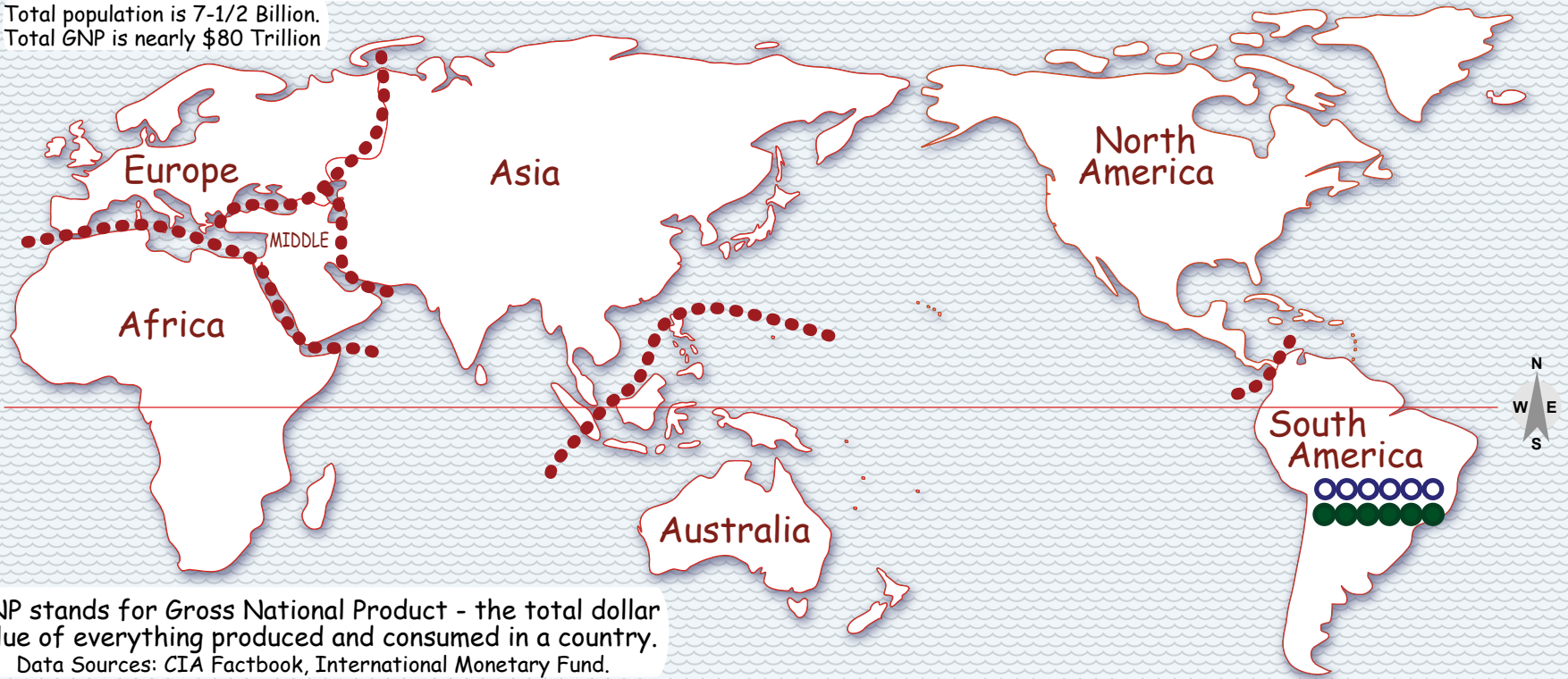


## Population and Wealth in the World - Who Has the Money?

Total population is 7-1/2 Billion.  
Total GNP is nearly \$80 Trillion



GNP stands for Gross National Product - the total dollar value of everything produced and consumed in a country.

Imagine that all the people in the world are represented by 100 symbols on a map, Each symbol represents about 75 million people.

1. Draw open circles ○ on the map above to show what percentage of all the world's people live in each world region:  
Africa 15    Europe 11    "Middle" 4    Asia 56    Australia/Islands 1/2    N America 8    S America 6
  
2. Draw solid circles ● to show what percentage of total income is earned in each region. Each symbol is about 800 billion dollars.  
Africa 4    Europe 34    "Middle" 3    Asia 24    Australia/Islands 1    N America 28    S America 6
