

In 2015, people in the United States bought more than 2 trillion dollars worth of things from people in other countries.

A trillion dollars is a thousand billion, or a million million. Because the United States has about 300 million people, that's about \$7000 for each person in the United States.

Make a map to show the major flows of imported goods.

- 1. Draw arrows to the United States from each country on the list.
- 2. Use the map key as a guide to make the thickness of each arrow. If the amount imported from a certain country is between the numbers on the key, make the arrow an in-between thickness.
- 3. You might have to experiment to draw arrows that do not overlap. For example, you might make some arrows curve a little on the way.
