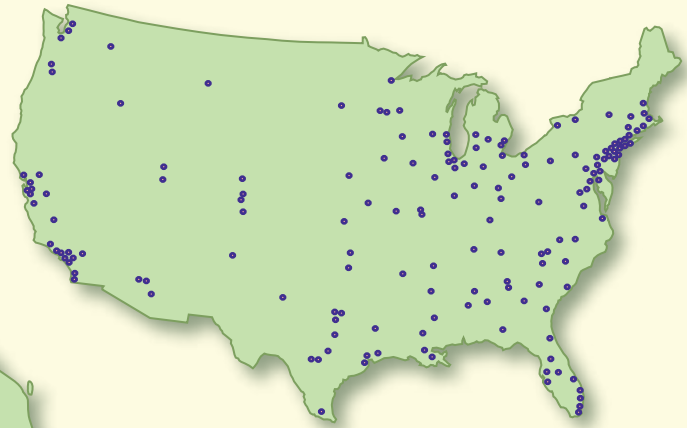
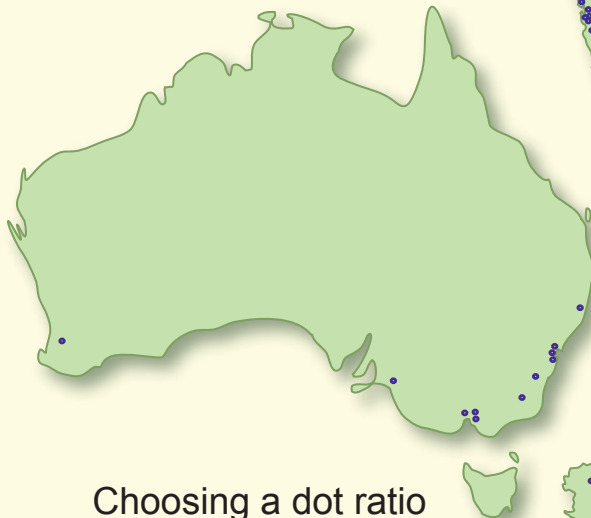


Visual Map Comparison



Each dot represents
2 million people

400 Miles



Choosing a dot ratio
is always a compromise.

If one dot shows 2 million people,
the dots overlap in crowded areas,
such as eastern China or New York.

At the same time, they cannot show
the actual pattern of population
in sparsely populated places,
like Australia or Montana.
