

How to Read a Climagraph - Hemispheres


A climagraph is a special kind of graph. It shows the average temperature and total precipitation (rain and snow) in each month at a place.


From this graph, you can see if the people in a place need furnaces, air conditioners, irrigation for their crops, or sprinklers for their lawns.

















- f 1. Which of these three climagraphs (circle: $A \ B \ C$) is from Congo, near the equator? Why do you think so?
