## DATA TABLE

Numbers show thousands of soldiers.

Four armies at Places A - D crossed the river at Places E and F and then joined at Place G.

### Size of army on way to Moscow

E	260	cross Niemen R. with Napoleon
F	110	cross Niemen R. farther south
G	330	join together to attack Vilnius
H	200	after 60,000 go north to Drissa
J	175	find Vitebsk abandoned, on fire
K	145	fight battle near Smolensk
L	130	"win" major battle at Borodino
M	100	arrive to capture Moscow

### Size of army on way back to France

N	90	leave Moscow (with little food)
K	35	cross river near Smolensk
O	50	including survivors from Drissa
G	25	survive attacks on way to Vilnius
E	15	cross river south of Kovno
	10	finally make it back in France
