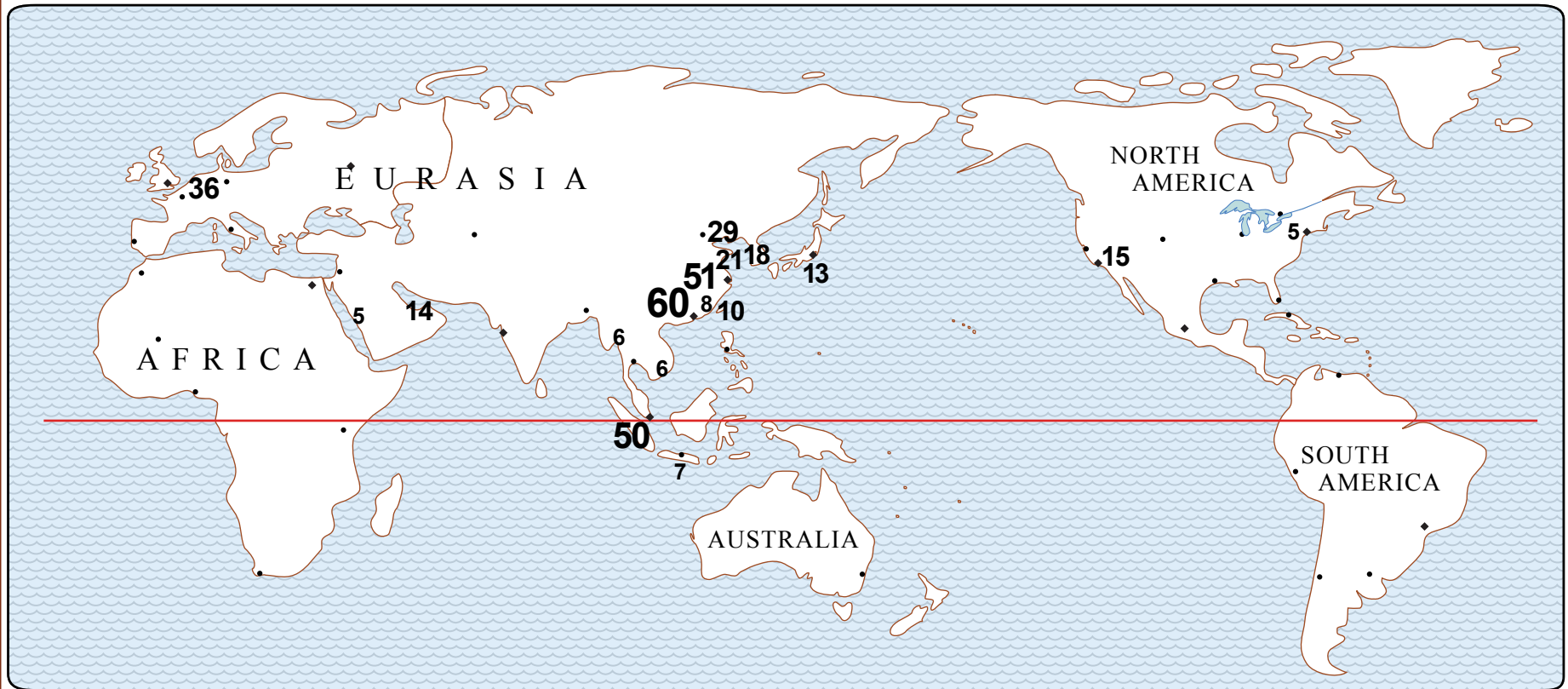


TOP CONTAINER PORTS IN THE WORLD

| 60 | Guangzhou-Hong Kong-Shenzhen (dot in S China) | 10 | Taiwan (small island east of mainland China) |
| 51 | Shanghai-Ningbo-Zhoushan (dot in E China) | 8 | Xiamen, China (mainland China near Taiwan) |
| 50 | Singapore-Malaysia (dot on equator) | 7 | Jakarta, Indonesia (dot on island S of Equator) |
| 36 | Antwerp-Rotterdam-Hamburg-Bremen (N Europe) | 6 | Laem Chabang, Thailand (west coast of SE Asia) |
| 29 | Tianjin-Dalian-Yingkou (bay near Beijing dot, N China) | 6 | Ho Chi Minh, Vietnam (SE coast of SE Asia) |
| 21 | Qingdao-Lianyungang (between Beijing and Shanghai) | 5 | New York-New Jersey, USA (dot on east coast) |
| 18 | Busan Korea (southern tip of Korea peninsula) | 5 | Jeddah, Saudi Arabia (near Mecca in W Arabia) |
| 15 | Los Angeles-Long Beach (dot in southern California) | | |
| 14 | Jebel Ali, Dubai (on Persian Gulf east coast of Arabia) | | |
| 13 | Tokyo-Yokohama-Osaka-Kobe, around dot in Japan | | |

Note that New York barely makes the top 30, and no port in India, Africa, or South America is on the list of top-30 container ports.
